IMMUNIZATIONS, PHYSICAL EXAMS, AND MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION NEW YORK STATE REQUIREMENTS TO ENTER SCHOOL PUBLIC OR PRIVATE

IMMUNIZATION POLICY

New York State requires proof of immunization.

ALL students from toddler to eighth grade must have proof of immunizations as required by law on or before the first day of school.

Those students who do not meet the required immunizations, without proof of medical exemption or serology (titers), will not be permitted to continue to attend school for more than 14 days.

Parents must provide the school with proof of immunity or proof of exemption as required by law.

PHYSICAL EXAM POLICY

Health exams are required for all new students.

New York state requires students in Pre-K or Kindergarten, and in grades 1,3,5, and 7 to have an exam.

Yearly exams are also required for your student to play sports. This, then, would include grades 6 and 8 as the 5th through 8th grades play sports here at Holy Child Academy.

Exams must be completed on the approved NYSED School Health Form. This form can be found and downloaded from our website.

MEDICATION POLICY

ALL medications, whether prescribed or over the counter, require a doctor's order which must be signed by the doctor and PARENT in order for a nurse to administer any medication to your child.
